Additional traffic calming measures for Hampton on the Hill

WCC Cllr Caborn gave an outline of measures from Graham Stanley, Road Safety, and the costs, which would have to come out of his budget of approximately £25,000. Provisional costings are £21,000 plus £6,000 for a feasibility study, which cannot come out of Cllr Caborn's budget. To be discussed at the Warwick District Traffic Seminar later this month.




