PLANNING MATTERS

PC considered response to application W17/2387: land off Daly Avenue - documents submitted by Chairman had been circulated, comments received from Cllr Roper were considered and Chairman will recirculate revised comments ready for submitting to also include A4189 & Tree Preservation Orders.

Chairman reported from meeting he & the Vice-Chairman had had with Richborough Estates. Discussion took place regards entry and exit routes to the proposed development. The traffic count has been extended to 13th March due to recent weather at no extra charge.
