Community Infrastructure Levy Survey

Community Infrastructure Levy [CIL] contributions from the companies building in Hampton Magna will be made to Budbrooke Parish Council [BPC] to be used for the benefit of our community. This could amount to over £200,000 in total, but it will come in increments.

The Budbrooke Neighbourhood Development Plan [BNDP] surveys identified several potential uses which are listed overleaf, but they are not exclusive and may not be feasible. You may feel that the money could be better spent, if so add your idea(s) to the list. This survey will help BPC decide what residents want. Once we have a longer list, which includes any new ideas we will ask you to vote for those you would prefer. BPC will then prioritise and make best use of the additional income.

Please be aware that the developers will have to provide some things as part of that development. For example, it is likely that they will provide any major infrastructure – sewers, drains, roads, footpaths and other physical structures that form the development and for education and health services. Exactly what these are and how they are delivered are not matters that the parish council can deal with. BPC's CIL money is in addition to these.

The parish council's view is that these funds should be used to help maintain the quality of life, as far as is reasonably possible, consistent with its Vision.

The Vision for Budbrooke

A Parish that retains its quiet rural charm, maintains the individual character of the settlements within it and grows in a way that is in keeping with the design of the surrounding area and reflects the needs of its residents.

So, we need your ideas.
