Cllr Rhead suggested PC consider Section 106 arrangement which is project specific. Chairman requested Cllrs to email him with main areas of concern, he will compile a draft to circulate to Members then Clerk to submit.

W18/1560 - 22 Cherry Lane: Proposed first floor rear extension and single storey front extension - ClIrs F & Mrs C Roper declared an interest & did not participate in discussion or vote. PC has no objections.

W18/1674 - Rose Cottage, Henley Rd, HOTH: Single storey rear extension - No objections.

PC noted the following results:

W18/1232 - 60 Old BB Rd - Erection of single storey front / side extension; single storey rear extension with proposed timber cladding to selected external corners of the house (Resubmission W/18/0341) -Granted


