WCC Highways Dept have the right to trim back overhanging branches and charge costs to the landowner

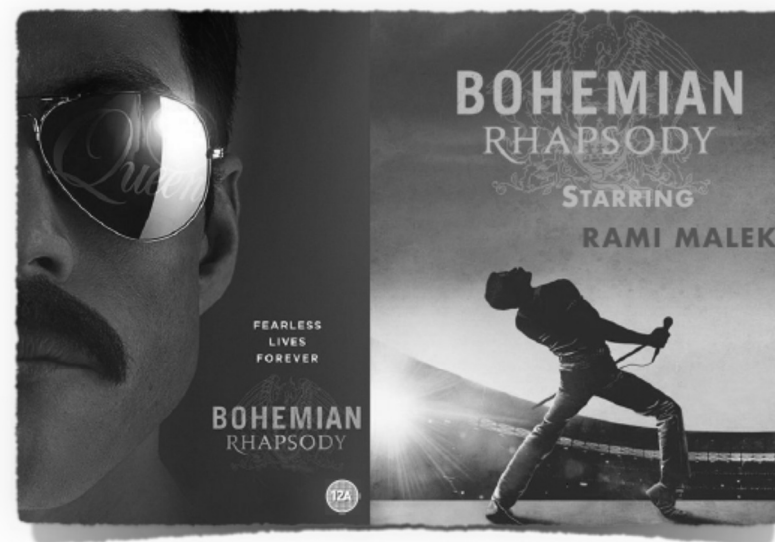
