Site visit Montgomery Avenue: Severn trent valve replacement works. Annual safety inspection booked at £86 per site. Overhanging hedges HOTH - reported to Highways for action. Blandford Way - Cllr Mrs Dutton reported residents comments - PC views with regards to additional access, Blandford Way - Cllr Matecki will check on guidance. Clerk to refer homeowner to Martin Davies.

Correspondence: A46 and M40 noise and fumes pollution in Hampton Magna: PC reported to Environmental Health for their views & awaiting response. Byelaws relating to dogs on leads in Styles Close HM: Clerk to book a time to see if they are in the Parish files.

Rewilding: Cllr Treacy asked whether the PC would be willing to sew wild flowers in the grassy areas at the end of closes in the parish to encourage insects. PC in agreement and will identify suitable areas.

The Fouling of Land by Dogs (Warwick District Council) Order 2011 requires owners to remove faeces deposited by their dog from any land to which the public have access in Warwick district and which is open to the air (including land which is covered but open to the air on at least one side). Persons contravening the Order may be prosecuted through the courts [maximum fine £1000] or given a fixed penalty charge.
