Public Participation (strictly limited to 5 minutes): 3 members of the public attended. CC Noticeboard

has arrived and is awaiting installation. 20 people attended Walking for Health walks last week.

Bellway development issues raised with sewer diversion concerns, Chairman will raise at tomorrow's

meeting. Also footings are going in for new homes and the ground level is being raised by at least 1m,

there is a row of 5 detached homes which will cause a large embankment between service road and

field, spoken to WDC Plg Enforcement but doesn't think this footpath is on the list for tarmacing and

will be hazardous in wet weather, Chairman will raise this also.

Apologies & Declarations Of Interest & Dispensations: Cllr Daffern. No declarations confirmed.

Approve March meeting minutes: Approved true & accurate, amend present list to include Cllr Matecki.

Planning: PC noted traffic survey results & discussed outcome including increases in some areas but

reductions in other areas - suggested repeat the survey when normality is resumed, agreed as there are

still concerns the survey will be repeated later in the year - Clerk to Agenda for August meeting.

Road surfaces in general along Old BB Road are suffering from increased traffic / HGVs, Clerk to email

David Cross to assess, HM side of the road is worse than the field side.

Issues raised through developer site email address & verbally have been circulated & were discussed

ahead of tomorrow's meeting, other issues were added to the list. Cllr Treacy put her name for speed training due to increasing speed of contractor vehicles- Clerk to

make arrangements & Chairman to prepare newsletter article. PC noted appeal from Church Farmhouse, Woodway, Budbrooke CV35 8Q (W19/1573LB) for first floor extension to residential barn.

BPC Planning working document: Chairman issued to PC for discussion. Plans were approved and agreed PC should submit to wider audience, PC agreed the newsletter would be the best option for consulting the parish but also an electronic survey link via the website, FB etc.

Wildflower Projects

As a resident of HM for over 17 years, I was excited to see a request for wildflower projects in the newsletter last year. I responded, and am really happy that we are going ahead with one of the ideas - a wildflower area in the circle that incorporates the 'Budbrooke Barracks' sign.

This means digging up the gravel that makes up the circle currently and replacing it with compost made from the recycled contents of our green bins!



Onto the wildflowers. In memory of the former barracks, the idea is that the flowers match the colours of the Royal Warwickshire Regiment. These are royal blue and orange, and rose and primrose.

The parish council has paid for an order of £360 of native wildflowers to fill the 40m^2 area including knapweed, periwinkles, deptford pinks, wild camomile to name a few! I have crocosmia bulbs for the orange and some lavender and rosemary for smell and structure. These should be ready to plant in the early summer so the gravel area needs to be ready to accept them by the end of April.

This will be a work in progress. Over the next 2 years, as flowers grow to fill the space, we can work out which flowers work well and which don't! I am not a gardener, just someone who loves flowers.
