Trees overhanging garden: Clerk to seek quotes to bring back to the PC.

Overhanging trees at The Montgomery: Clerk to write to the Pub Occupier to request maintenance.

Consultation on Proposed South Warwickshire Council: Chairman reported the rationale behind the proposals.

Correspondence from the Open Door: this was received and discussed. With regards to the Train, Chairman had commented that the PC may consider this, PC need to see further details of the requested train before they can make a final decision. To clarify the issue with regards to minutes, Cllr Bryan had never received any invitations to any of the meetings and other things discussed were not a matter for public consultation.

WALC re. WCC Highways Verge mgt policy consultation: Highways wish to reduce cutting to once per year, PC to respond to confirm understand the importance and are currently looking at ways of rewilding and maintaining verges. Clerk to respond, positive but needs further consideration.

Parish Maintenance/Playgrounds:

PC received monthly inspection reports and has today chased the annual safety inspection.

Chipping store next to the Stables, there is a tree that looks dangerous, Aspen adj to the road that needs some attention.

From HM to HOTH round sharp bend used to be a sign to warn of oncoming traffic in middle of road, now not there, request to have it replaced, Clerk to request sign on LEFT.

Signage for walkers last time - Clerk to ask Graham Stanley . WCC to put it forward on our behalf.

Overhanging trees and bushes at corner of Daly Avenue, agreed Cllrs R & M Treacy-Hales will arrange.

Resident in Normandy Close re. Playing field - tree blocking the light, trees, size, lack of light etc.

Bollards on Old Budbrooke Road by the brook, were replaced recently but now 5 missing.

BT Kiosk update

Community Centre: BCC Mgt Cttee & Officers are wishing to step down for various reasons and wanted to inform the PC so a controlled transition could be in place. Some officers have already exceeded their terms. Majority of Committee and Officers will be standing down. Officially informing PC and seek help / offers to replace. BCC have put requests out. The Chairman, Vice-Chairman, Treasurer and Secretary are all moving on, there are other residents on the Committee. User groups and parents could be approached, if the CC closes it would affect the wider community. Also to discuss in detail at the AGM, if people aren't willing to take it on then the CC must cease to function. Cllr Treacy-Hales suggesting changing the constitution to a shorter term which may encourage more people to come forward. Next step is newsletter / fliers to inform the community of the gravity of the situation.

Finance: PC noted successful findings of external audit & approved payments & Bank reconciliation. PC agreed the outgoing Clerk be paid an additional months salary to overlap and handover to the new Clerk.

Newsletter/Website/FB Items: nothing additional to add. Clerk to find out from WDC how many new occupiers there are with the new developments.

If you are between 18 and 65 and eligible for the flu we are now running very low on stock of these vaccines so if you are intending to have your flu jab please phone and book in ASAP. We do have another delivery booked however we will have limited stock.

We have 2&3 year nasals and over 65's in stock and would appreciate you booking in online or via reception as staff capacity is too low to make our usual phone calls

Development at Budbrooke

Budbrooke is having a portakabin installed to hold some appointment in there. The portakabin will be located in front of the dispensary.

Other local GP's have adopted this solution to reduce pressures within the building. The Open door have therefore lent us two of their car parking spaces that will be re-marked to ensure we can move our disabled spaces – we cannot thank them enough. The portakabin can be used easily by clinicians to see patients, to reduce some of the winter pressures and to be able to have more staff working safely in peak times. We are also working some evenings and staff have increased some of their hours to provide more availability during this extremely busy period.

We have also managed to secure air filters via public health and waiting for these to arrive. There are now several seats available in the waiting room, but using the windows and doors as ventilation, with all available openings open. This sometimes means the practice maybe cold, so please wrap up warm. The air filter machines will be with us shortly, however public health has advised air flow is extremely important in our fight against the spread of Covid in areas such as practice waiting rooms. The other option is to book yourself in with reception and wait in your car until you are called in to see your clinician. Please agree this with reception.

We hope that patients understand why we have taken these preventive steps, including seeking assistance from public health to ensure we provide a safe and effective environment for our staff and patients.
