BE AWARE - DISTRACTION BURGLARIES IN THE LOCAL AREA

It has been reported that an incident occurred on Wednesday 7 June 2023 in Hampton Magna.

At approximately 14:00 hours 2 unknown males entered 2 homes claiming to be from a utility company. One of the males went into the home with the victim whilst the other male made untidy searches of the property. Further information is listed below in the report from Warwickshire Police and Warwickshire Connected. Please be vigilant

- 1. Put the chain on before you open the door as this is a barrier against unwanted callers
- 2. When an unexpected caller claims they work for a utility company, they must be able to quote your password and unique customer number and produce an identity card
- 3. If someone claims to be from the police, they should carry an ID card with their photograph on - check this carefully and keep the chain on. This also applies to genuine tradespeople.
- 4. If you're unsure about the caller's identity, telephone the company the caller claims to represent, but don't rely on them giving you the number as it may be false - genuine callers won't mind waiting
- 5. If you're still unsure, ask the caller to come back later so that you can arrange for a friend or relative to be present
- 6. If you feel uncomfortable or are concerned with the person's presence, call 101 or 999 if a crime is in action

Mobile Phone Use Whilst Driving

It has been reported that the number of people using their mobile phones whilst driving around the parish has substantially increased. This is both dangerous and illegal. The below is an extract from a recent police report – take note please!

Police officers caught 98 drivers using their mobile phone illegally at the wheel and 100 people not wearing a seatbelt during the recent week of action, tagged Operation Vertebrae,

In the Midlands, there were 123 offences recorded by Warwickshire Police including 63 people not wearing a seatbelt and 19 using a mobile phone. While Central Motorway Police Group recorded 127 offences including 52 people using their mobile phone at the wheel and 31 not wearing a seatbelt.


