Saturday 9th December 2023 – come and plant a tree in Montgomery Avenue Park!

Budbrooke Parish Council has been successful in applying for 420 free trees to be planted this winter in Montgomery Avenue Park, and we need YOUR help to plant them. The tiny saplings will be planted form hedgerows, and a few will also be scattered throughout the park to provide shade and improve biodiversity. The trees will be a mix of species chosen for their year-round colour, in order to enhance the natural beauty of the park, and will include hawthorn, dogwood, wild cherry, silver birch, rowan and hazel. They have been donated by the Woodland Trust.

Budbrooke Parish Council has received support from local resident Amy Bambridge, from the Trees Call to Action Project, based at the Heart of England Forest. Amy is working with all Parish Councils in the area to support Warwick District Council with plans to plant 160,000 new trees by 2030.

We hope to make the day one of fun for all the family; Anyone is welcome, and you can plant as many or as few trees as you wish. We intend to be able to supply spades and gloves on the day for those who don't have their own (subject to confirmation closer to the time).

If you'd like to come along and help, please email the Parish Clerk, Ronnie Poole (budbrookepc@gmail.com) and let us know how many people will be in your party. We will provide more detailed information on timings etc in the Autumn.




