## County Council Elections confirmed with key dates

Residents living in Warwick District will get the opportunity to have their say on who represents them locally for the next four years with Warwickshire County Council Elections set to take place on Thursday 1 May.

There are currently 14 County Councillors each representing a division (ward) within the district boundary, with the divisions remaining unchanged since the last elections in 2021.

Warwick District Council's elections team, who are administering the elections on behalf of the County Council are keen to ensure that everyone who is eligible is able to take part, with a special appeal to residents who have just turned 18 or have changed their address to make sure they are [registered to vote](#) ahead of the deadline of **midnight on Friday 11 April**.

The Council is also issuing a reminder that anyone wishing to vote at a polling station will be required to show an accepted form of photographic ID, with a list available on the [Electoral Commission's website](#). Those without eligible ID have the opportunity to apply for a free voter authority certificate **by 5pm on Wednesday 23 April**.

- [Apply for a proxy vote](#) by 5pm Wednesday 23 April 2025
